

Dance Dress Code Guidelines

The Eighth Grade Dance is a special event that we all look forward to each year. We have put together the following dress code guidelines for students and guests so that you can prepare ahead of time while shopping for appropriate attire.

Young men:

- Dress pants that are secured at the waist
- Collared dress or polo style shirt
- A tie and/or jacket (optional).

Young women:

- Must wear a dress or dress pants, that is in good taste.
- The outfit may not be made of see-through material or tightly fitting stretchy material (such as Spandex)
- Dresses must have two straps worn over the shoulder or one strap that secures around the neck
- No open styles, which show the entire back or stomach areas, are permitted.
- All dresses must cover the midriff area completely.
- Front necklines shall not be lower than a line formed between the right and left armpit so that cleavage is not showing.
- The dress length and all slits cannot exceed more than three inches above the knee and must be no longer than your shin (no floor length gowns) and must remain at appropriate length during movement.

Students will not be admitted wearing cargo pants, denim, jeans, t-shirts, torn clothing, chains/spikes, sexually implicit or explicit clothes, shorts, hats and head coverings, bandanas, canes, or items referencing tobacco or alcohol products.

Only students meeting the dress requirements will be admitted to the dance. If you have questions concerning attire, it is your responsibility to seek prior approval from an administrator. Any questions regarding dress should be resolved before the evening of the dance. If you arrive at the dance dressed inappropriately, you will be asked to leave and a refund will **not** be granted.
