### Notes from the School Nurse

We all are aware of what COVID-19 is and the signs and symptoms of the virus. I wanted to answer some most common questions that parents have.

#### Q: My child is sick with COVID symptoms what should I do?

A: Keep your child home and notify the school of the absence.

- According to the CDC guidance your child will need to stay home for:
  - At least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared and
  - \* At least 24 hours have passed since last fever without the use of fever reducing medications and
  - Symptoms have improved

#### Students may return in fewer than 10 days with school nurse (RN) verification of one of the following:

Return to school note from a doctor's office

Documentation of negative PCR COVID-19 test

#### **Recommendations**:

We want to ensure that your family is healthy. If you student is having COVID-19 symptoms seeing a provider is recommended. You student may have flu or strep or could have a secondary infection related to another virus. A COVID testing site should not be your source of a diagnosis.

#### Q: My child is sick should I go get a test?

A: If you child is sick please call your child's primary care office and make an appointment. Your provider will make recommendations after the assessment of your child. They may perform other diagnostic tests to rule out COVID.

#### Q: A COVID test is recommended by the doctor what should I do?

A: If a COVID test is recommended there are a few options.

- The school district offers free testing for students. You need to contact your school nurse. After speaking with your school nurse, she may place you on a list to receive a free test. Once placed on the list you will call a number and a nurse will schedule you at 1 of the 3 testing sites located throughout the county.
- If getting a test from a provider's office or urgent care, please know the school district only accepts a positive rapid antigen or positive PCR test or negative PCR test. WE DO NOT ACCEPT A NEGATIVE RAPID ANTIGEN OR AN ANTIBODY TEST.

#### Q: My student is positive for COVID 19 what do I do?

A: Contact your school and notify the school nurse. Your school nurse will have questions such as when did your symptoms start, when did you get tested, what type of test you had and if there are any other siblings in the school system? Your school nurse will also need a copy of the results to be able to help with notifying the DOH of the positive case.

#### Q: Someone in my house tested positive to COVID or I have been exposed to someone with COVID what do I do?

A: Contact your school and your school nurse. Your school nurse will call you to get the name, date of birth, date of the onset of symptoms, test date, type of test and ask for a copy of the results. The information is passed onto the DOH and a case is generated. Your child will have to stay home and is now considered QUARANTINED.

#### Q: Should I send my child to school while awaiting results of their COVID test?

A: No, if your child received a test they need to stay home until test results are in. Once test results are in a copy of the results will need be sent to your school nurse, so your child is clear to return to school.

#### Q: Should I send my child to school if someone other than my child in my home has a pending COVID test?

A: The student may come to school if someone in the home has a pending test result. If that result is positive, then they will be pulled from school and quarantined. However, if results are positive and you plan to go get your child tested then I would suggest NOT sending them to school. If you child ends up being positive and they have been at school,

potential students and staff will now be placed on quarantine for 14 days. I would guide you to think of the 'What If', when choosing to send your child to school with pending test results in the house.

## Common Questions when Students are Quarantined:

#### Q: Should I go get a test?

A: Depends on the situation. If you are having signs and symptoms, then YES you should test. If you are having no signs and symptoms, then testing soon after exposure will more likely yield a negative result. If you feel like you need to test due to exposure it is best to test later in the quarantine period such as day 10 after exposure.

#### Q: I am quarantined my test is negative so can I come back to school?

A: No, you may not come back to school until your quarantine ends even with a negative test. You may have tested too early into your quarantine period and tested negative. You must adhere to the Department of Health (DOH) date of return to school. PLEASE SEE ILLUSRATION BELOW FOR UNDERSTANDING.

#### Q: Who determines when my child can come back to school?

**A:** The DOH determines after contact tracing when the return date is. THE SCHOOL HAS NO CONTROL OVER END DATES. The typical amount of days is 14 days from exposure, however if the case is in the house and the person isn't isolated from the rest of the family the amount of quarantine days will be longer than 14 days.

# Breakfast and Lunch Changes



Due to changes in the rules governing the federal school lunch program, Pasco Schools is making it easier than ever for students – and children 18 and under – to receive free meals. Any student who attends classes on campus will still be able to get their meals in the school cafeteria, and now those meals, for EVERY student will be free. In addition, students who attend school remotely, will still be able to receive school meals on a drive-through basis. Those meals also will be free. Here's how the program will work for students who are learning remotely through mySchool Online or Pasco eSchool:

- The school district will also serve a week's worth of meals (breakfast and lunch) curbside to mySchool Online students, quarantined students, and children in the community 18 years and under. That includes Pasco e-School students. We will keep the same times already established for curbside feeding. Curbside meal distribution will continue once a week on Fridays. Designated locations and times are listed at <a href="https://connectplus.pasco.k12.fl.us/do/fns/?page\_id=6877">https://connectplus.pasco.k12.fl.us/do/fns/?page\_id=6877</a>.
- We encourage families intending to participate curbside to complete the Meal Reservation Form, <u>http://www.pasco.k12.fl.us/fns/mform/view.php?id=269401</u>, so we can be best prepared for curbside participation. Parent/guardians no longer have to go to their child's school; they can pick up meals from the site that is most convenient.
