RBSMS Student Dress Code

Schools are professional environments and students are expected to dress appropriately. School authorities may limit or prohibit any extreme type or style of student dress, which, in the judgment of school officials, is deemed to create a disruption of the educational process.

The following attire is considered inappropriate dress:

- Holes or frays in jeans/pants that are above the knee and expose skin, pants that sag, or pajamas.
- Pants or jeans that drag on the floor or expose undergarments.
- Items of clothing that expose the midriff or reveal cleavage, tank tops, off-the-shoulder tops, halter tops or other garments with spaghetti straps or other similar straps.
- Hats and hoods are not to be worn in buildings/classrooms.
- Bandanas, hip chains, and spiked clothing/accessories.
- All spandex clothing and leggings worn as pants.
 - Slippers.
 - Accessories and clothing with obscene, crude or rude writing pertaining to drugs, alcohol, violence (including weapons of any kind), sex, or racial context.
