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Dear MSOL Parents and Guardians,

Per the Florida Department of Education, All MSOL students are required to come on campus for all FSA testing. The FSA ELA Writing Assessment is scheduled to be administered at RBSMS on the following days:

6<sup>th</sup> grade will be testing Monday, April 5<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 a.m.

7<sup>th</sup> grade will be testing Monday, April 12<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 a.m.

8<sup>th</sup> grade will be testing Monday, April 19<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 a.m.

Please drop your MSOL student off by 8:30 a.m. on the appropriate grade level testing day. MSOL students will be assigned to either the cafeteria or the multi-purpose room in the gymnasium. Please drop your child off near their testing location. The students will receive their testing location on Monday, March 29<sup>th</sup> from their 1<sup>st</sup> period teacher. It is important that all 7<sup>th</sup> grade and 8<sup>th</sup> grade MSOL students who have a school-assigned computer need to bring it with them when coming to campus for testing.

Students will be testing until approximately 11:30 a.m. so please plan on picking your child up in front of our gymnasium at that time. Some students have a specific accommodation of extended time. If your child has extended time on their 504 or IEP, we will allow that student to contact you when they finish with their test if they go past 11:30 a.m. You may want to send your child with a lunch in case they go past their 11:30 time frame.

In addition to the FSA Writing assessment our students will also participate in the final MAPs assessment throughout the month of April. Students' attendance will be crucial for the months of April and May as our teachers and students are preparing and participating in end of the year FSA, MAPs, and district final assessments. We will continue to support our district's health and safety procedures during our testing sessions.

Stay tuned for the May testing schedule for FSA Reading/Math, Science, EOCs (Civics, Algebra) and District Finals.
