<b>Be Respectful</b> Acting positively toward someone or something	Treat everyone and their belongings with thoughtfulness and kindness. Follow directions as well as classroom rules and procedures.	Listen to the drivers and assistants. Follow bus rules.	Be considerate of others at your table and around you. Follow directions from all adults.	Use appropriate language and interact positively with your peers.
<b>Be Successful</b> Purposefully working toward meeting goals and expectations	Do your best work, and allow others to do the same.	Stop and think about bus safety before acting.	Know your lunch number if you are getting school lunch. Eat your food in timely fashion and throw all of your trash away when you are finished.	Get to your destination before the tardy bell.
<b>Be Safe</b> Actively working to avoid harm to yourself or others	Keep hands and feet to yourselves. Move through the room safely. Objects should never be thrown. Be familiar with Crisis Plans.	Follow all bus safety rules. Stay seated when the bus is moving. Keep body and objects out of the aisle.	Only sit in designated seats. Use hand sanitizer, or wash your hands, before eating lunch. Do not throw food or objects. Keep hands and feet to yourself.	Keep hands and feet to yourself. Walk safely to the next classroom. Follow correct pathway and stairwell directions.
