Step 5: ADMINISTRATIVE INTERVENTION w/parent contact documented in EWS

- Contact administrator to provide specifics
- Teacher inputs disciplinary referral in MyStudent and calls parent to explain why the student is receiving the referral.
- Every additional incident of the same behavior will result in a referral.

Step 4: TEAM INTERVENTION w/ parent contact documented in EWS

- Team Time Out (1 period) with PLC/Team Partner
- Lunch Detention (3-5 days depending on the infraction)
- Daily Bulldog Expectations Point Sheet
- Parent Conference with Teacher or Team if all teachers experience the same behavior
- Revoke passing privileges for a set period of time
- After School Detention

Step 3: OUTSIDE CLASSROOM INTERVENTION

w/ parent contact documented in EWS

- Team Time Out (5 min. to 30 min.) with PLC/Team Partner
- Lunch Detention (1-2 days depending on the infraction)
- School Counselor/Social Worker/Nurse/SSAP referral
- Team conference with Student and School Counselor

Step 2: CLASS INTERVENTION

w/ parent contact documented in EWS

- Think Sheet
- Loss of privileges in classroom
- Seat Change
- Brief student/teacher conference either before/after class (privately)

Step 1: CONFERENCE WITH THE STUDENT

Individually remind the student of the infraction and the expected behavior

- Student Code of Conduct
- Classroom Rules/Procedures
- Town Hall Meetings
