Consequences



Step 1 (1st Violation)

- Teacher confiscates device for the period and contacts parent/guardian.
- Student will receive a minor infraction.
- Review WCD policy with student.

Step 1 (2nd Violation)

- Back office holds device until parent/guardian picks it up.
- Student will receive a minor infraction.
- Review WCD district policy with student.

Step 2 (3rd Violation)

- Back office holds device until parent/guardian picks it up.
- Student will receive a minor infraction.
- Review WCD district policy with student.
- Lunch detention assigned.

Step 3 (4th Violation)

- Back office holds device until parent/guardian picks it up.
- Student will receive a minor infraction.
- Review WCD district policy with student.
- Behavior Agreement signed.
- After school detention assigned.

Step 4 (5th Violation)

- Back office holds device until parent/guardian picks it up.
- Student will receive a discipline referral.
- Review WCD district policy and review behavior agreement with student.
- Parent/Teacher Conference
- Device checked in to Back Office for two weeks.
- May result in ISS or OSS
